GUIDELINES FOR THE LEAD TEACHERS/COACHES

3 Stage Process

First Stage:

- Public and private schools are invited to participate.
- Students aged 9-13 yrs begin to prepare months before the competition- the Semi-Finals and Finals.
- Schools decide on their method of student selection for the Semi-Finals.
- In-school competitions are conducted.
- By December 12th, all schools are to register the names of the 3 students and 1 substitute student who will be entered in the Semi-Finals. In early November, coaches will receive a link to the registration form.

Second Stage:

 All schools will be divided into 3 regions for the Spelling Bee.

Eastern Region (8)

Western Region (9)

Bermuda Institute, Dalton E. Tucker, Paget Primary, Port Royal, Purvis, Sandys Secondary Middle, Somerset Primary, Warwick Academy, West End Primary.
